

What is the 50/50 draw?

A fundraising initiative, with 50% of proceeds going to the lucky winners and 50% going to the club to improve bowling facilities.

Entry into the 50-50 draw is open to VPBC members and supporters. Persons under 18 years of age are not eligible to participate.

How do I enter?

Set up a monthly standing order with a payment date **no later than 14th** of the month to be paid into:

Account name: Victoria Park 50-50 Club

Sort code: **01-00-53**

Account: **12759317**

Enter your name in the reference field

How much does it cost to enter?

Minimum entry fee of £5 per draw.

Can I have multiple entries in a single draw?

Yes, if you wish to have two entries per draw (for example), you should set up a Standing order for £10 per month. There is no maximum limit.

How do I know what my draw number(s) are?

You will receive notification (by email) of your draw number(s) once your first payment has been received. Your draw number will remain yours until you withdraw from the 50/50 club by cancelling your standing order payment.

How many prizes are there?

There will be three prizes each month. One ticket number will be drawn for each prize: 1st, 2nd, and 3rd. The participant owning the Ticket Number will be entitled to that prize.

The prize fund will be allocated as follows:

1st prize	60% of the prize fund
2nd prize	30% of the prize fund
3rd prize	10% of the prize fund

Do the draws continue outside the bowling season?

Yes, the 50/50 draw will operate 12 months per year.

How will winners be notified?

Winning participants will be notified by email. Winning Ticket Numbers and the amount donated to VPBC funds will be published in the VPBC newsletter.

What is the cut-off date for entry into the monthly draw?

Payment must be received by 21st of the month to be entered into that month's draw.
Payment received after the 21st will be entered into the following month's draw.

When will the first draw be held?

Friday 29 April - during the evening match held at Victoria Park
